## Shelter News

We are also proud to report that we have had another resident pass and receive her Certified Nursing Assistant certification. She has been volunteering her time at Stuart Nursing and Restorative Center and we hope that she will be able to gain employment as a Certified Nursing Assistant after she has her baby.

One of our residents is enrolled online with Florida Virtual School to complete her credits to receive her high school diploma. An essay she wrote was selected to be published in a hard-bound anthology, *Celebrating What is Important to Me*. We are very proud of her hard work and are excited to see this book.

We have a couple of residents working on their GED's and thanks to Molly, one of our volunteers, these two women are now receiving private tutoring.



We recently were able to purchase two new curriculums. Both series provide lessons that are taught at the shelter on a weekly basis. The first program teaches

life skills while providing the women with support to help meet the physical and emotional needs during pregnancy. The second lesson is a bible study that will help the women to understand the importance of God in their lives. We have a wonderful couple, Frank and Florie, who have volunteered to teach this curriculum.

The Paralegal Association of Florida had a diaper drive on our behalf. We have been receiving diapers on a weekly basis and we are so grateful! Within the next two months we will have four infants in the house and these diapers will help out tremendously.

MIS Consulting from Stuart has graciously volunteered to provide support for all our computer needs. We greatly appreciate their efforts and are so excited to have this help.
